



Kamnoetvidya Science Academy Announcement

Subject: Admission of Grade 10 Students for the Academic Year 2027

The PTT Group, which supports the establishment and operation of Kamnoetvidya Science Academy, has a firm goal and determination to have Kamnoetvidya Science Academy provide education to support government policies in using science and technology to develop the country. This is part of helping to develop high-level human resources who can conduct research, collaborate and compete internationally, create knowledge, invent, and develop various innovations for Thai society and the nation, as well as add value to Thai products and reduce dependency on knowledge, technology, and innovation from foreign countries.

Kamnoetvidya Science Academy intends to accept applications from students currently studying in Grade 9 or equivalent in the academic year 2026 to select 72 students for Grade 10 in the academic year 2027, with details as follows:

1. Applicant Qualifications

- 1.1 Currently studying in Grade 9 or equivalent in the academic year 2026
- 1.2 Meet one of the following criteria:
 - 1.2.1 Have a grade point average of 3.50 or higher in foundational mathematics and science subjects for Grades 7 and 8, and a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or higher in all subjects, or
 - 1.2.2 Passed the first-round selection of the Genius Project by the Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) for Grade 4-6 students, or
 - 1.2.3 Received awards in national or international mathematics or science competitions between Grade 4 and Grade 9
- 1.3 Be a Thai national with a valid Thai national ID.
- 1.4 Be diligent, well-behaved, and possess a pleasant personality.
- 1.5 Be highly interested to study at Kamnoetvidya Science Academy and receive the support from parents/guardians.
- 1.6 Be free from serious health issues that could hinder studying and living in the school's dormitory.
- 1.7 Be able to stay in the dormitory as a boarding school student and be willing to comply with current and future school regulations



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2. Application Period

Applications are open from **Tuesday, September 1 to Wednesday, September 30, 2026**

3. Number of Students Accepted

A total of 72 students will be accepted. Of these, 66 will be selected from applicants from all provinces, and 6 quota places will be reserved for students studying in schools located in the Eastern Economic Corridor (EEC) special development zone in 4 provinces, as detailed in section 4.

4. Quota for Students from Schools in the 4 Provinces

The school has set a quota of 6 students who study in schools located in the 4 provinces who passed the first and second rounds of selection, distributed as follows:

5. Scholarships and Conditions

- 5.1 Students selected to attend Kamnoetvidya Science Academy will receive scholarships which cover tuition fees, educational fees, accommodation fees, and food expenses.
- 5.2 The scholarships mentioned in 5.1 are grants given as awards to those with special abilities in mathematics and science in the country, who will be important forces and leaders in developing the nation in the future.
- 5.3 Selected students must stay in the dormitory provided by the school throughout their study period and must comply with the school's regulations, rules, and practices.
- 5.4 Scholarship recipients must be dedicated to their studies, committed to developing themselves to their fullest potential, discover their aptitudes and interests, be determined to pursue further education and careers as researchers in their fields of aptitude and interest. Talented individuals should possess ideals and show commitment to develop the nation, be selfless, have a public mind, and prioritize public interest over personal interest.

6. Application Process

- 6.1 Students must apply online through the application system at admission.kvis.ac.th only.
- 6.2 Students do not need to pay an application fee.
- 6.3 Students must fill in all information and submit the supporting documents as per items 6.3.1 to 6.3.4 through the application system at admission.kvis.ac.th by **Wednesday, September 30, 2026**.
 - 6.3.1 A photo of the student in school uniform (file format .jpg or .png, size 300x400 pixels).
 - 6.3.2 Document certifying the applicant's qualifications using Form No. 1.
 - 6.3.3 For students using qualifications 1.2.2 or 1.2.3, please submit documents showing that the student passed the first-round selection of the Genius Project by the Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) for Grade 4-6 students, or



certificates of awards received in national or international mathematics or science competitions between Grade 4 and Grade 9.

6.3.4 A document showing the student's commitment to studying STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) written by the student and parents/guardian using Form No. 2.

6.4 The school will announce the list of eligible candidates for the first-round selection on **Friday, October 30, 2026**

7. First Round Selection Examination and Venues

7.1 The school will hold the first round selection examination on **Saturday, November 21, 2026**, at 12 examination venues. During the application process, students should specify their preferred examination venue. **Once selected, the examination venue cannot be changed.**

8. Announcement of First Round Selection Results

- 8.1 The school shall announce the official list of 200 successful candidates from the first-round selection, together with an additional 20 candidates on the waiting list, making a total of 220 candidates. The selection shall be based on the total scores of the Mathematics and Science examinations, as specified in item 7.2, with equal weight assigned to both subjects.
- 8.2 The first round selection results will be announced on **Friday, December 25, 2026**, on the website admission.kvis.ac.th

9. Second Round Selection

The school shall announce the details and procedures for the second-round selection in the announcement of the first-round selection results, and the personal profile in item 7.2 shall be considered in the second-round selection.

10. Changes or Cancellation of Procedures According to Kamnoetvidya Science Academy

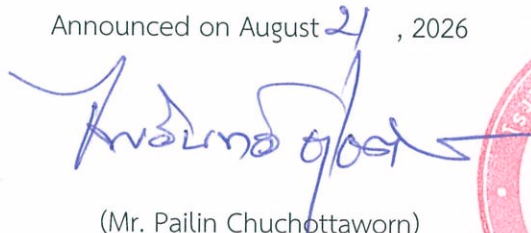
11. General Agreement
